





TOTAL INDIVIDUAL STUDENTS SERVED IN 2017: 369 students

The Association offered ten (10) adult education programs in both the inner city and northeast section of Edmonton. Programs were offered in six (6) locations in addition to individual tutoring sessions offered by the Centre's volunteer tutors in support of lower income adult students; individual tutoring sessions occurred throughout the city in areas most amenable to students. All of the Association programs are tuition-free for students.
